## Correcting State-Issued Identification



Identification Cards & Driver's Licenses

In the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, you can legally correct your gender on your state-issued identification card or driver's license by following these three easy steps.

- 1. Download or pickup the DL-32 form needed to change your gender marker.
- 2. Fill out the form and get a money order or check in the amount of \$30.50.
- 3. Take the completed form and your form of payment to your local DMV.

## Where to find the DL-32 form and your local DMV

## Fee information/Non-commercial license

If you would like to change your gender marker on a non-commercial license, the fee is \$35.50 rather than \$30.50. Make sure to double check the fee information on the back of the DL-32 form before you get a money order or check in the designated amount. The fees will cover the correction and reprint of your Pennsylvania driver's license or identification card. At some locations, you may be able to pay with a credit card.
